## Youth Envisioning the Future in Europe and Africa

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVE:

strengthen capacity for innovative approaches to development awareness, empowering those of secondary school age in Germany, Austria and Romania to be engaged with development issues and take action in peer-to-peer education and campaigning activities to hold governments to account for delivering on different aspects of the MDGs.

## Youth Envisioning the Future in Europe and Africa

### THE MAIN PROJECT ACTIVITIES ARE:

Delivery of a **multi-country development awareness programme**, creating a core package for a different theme each year:

- ▶ HIV/AIDS – 1<sup>st</sup> year;
- ▶ child and maternal health – 2<sup>nd</sup> year;
- ▶ food security – 3<sup>rd</sup> year.

The package includes: film material where appropriate; teaching materials for lesson plans; how to take action packs for teachers and young people and a pack to run the young leaders forum.

Delivery of an **annual young leaders forum**

Implementation of follow-up peer-to-peer development awareness and campaign actions which includes a competition for the most innovative approach to peer education.

Evaluation of the development awareness activities in each country, synthesis of the multi-country learnings and sharing findings with **academic** and development education institutions.

## SPECIFIC ACTIVITIES IN ROMANIA

---

- ▶ Adapt the core development awareness package, and ensure usage in schools and youth groups.
- ▶ Involve 20 schools from Cluj area, with teachers and young people trained to use the materials.
- ▶ Networking and Meetings with other NGO's and Development Education Platforms to show that controversial topics of the right to reproductive health and HIV & AIDS can be addressed.
- ▶ Organise an annual young leaders forum in the first two years of the project and an international youth forum in the least year of the project (young people from Ghana, Sierra Leone, Ethiopia and the Republic of Moldova)
