The role of the NIS in global reporting

- Decision no.1 at the 47th Session of the UN Statistical Commission:
"The development of global indicators will rely heavily on national, comparable and standardized official statistics provided by countries to international statistical systems, and when other sources and methodologies are used, **they will be reviewed and approved by the national statistical authorities** and presented in a transparent way"

National monitoring – current state

- RO : SDI set
- RO : SDIT set
 - 2 SD National Coferences (2010 and 2012)
- SDI set – Eurostat
- Europa 2020 indicators set – Eurostat

Romanian SDI set

- includes 103 indicators;
- is structured on the objectives of the NSDS;
- is organized on three levels:
 - level 1 - main indicators: 19 indicators;
 - level 2 - complementary indicators: 37 indicators;
 - level 3 - NSDS progress indicators: 47 indicators;
- is distributed on the 3 pillars of SD:
 - environment (48 indicators)
 - social (31 indicators)
 - economic (24 indicators).

NIS priorities

- Setting up a Roadmap for reporting on Agenda 2030;
- data collection for Agenda 2030 indicators
- data validation for Agenda 2030 indicators
- transmission of data to international / regional bodies according to the schedule established by the IAEG-SDG

Ongoing work on **SDG** indicators

- the reporting mechanism will be established
- international standards to be respected at national level will be agreed
- metadata for indicators will be completed
- preparing for set of the reporting deadline

National monitoring - perspectives



- **National objectives and targets - monitoring**
 - an integrated and robust approach from a technical point of view of the measurement methods
 - NIS - coordinating role
 - increasing the use of statistics in decision-making
